




This is a condensation of Bangor's Firearms Discharge Ordinance. The complete ordinance may be found in Chapter 113 §113-2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bangor.

Although the City of Bangor does not regulate hunting, the discharge of firearms during hunting may take place only in Zone 2, shown on the above map, and then only under the following conditions:

1. The firearms user must be the owner of the property he is shooting on, or have written permission from the owner or tenant of the property (Owner and tenant if the property is occupied by the tenant.)
2. The written permission to discharge a firearm must be carried on the person of the shooter.
3. Shotguns or firearms of .22 cal or smaller may not be discharged within 300' of any dwelling or public way.
4. Firearms larger than .22 cal (excepting shotguns) may not be discharged within 600' of any dwelling or public way.

NOTE: Notwithstanding the provisions of this ordinance, the unsafe handling or discharge of a firearm, or the disregard of "No Trespassing" signs, may give rise to criminal liability under State Statutes regarding reckless conduct or trespass.
