<u>Higher Ground Services Counseling & Case Management</u>

Abbie Foresteire

- Opened in 2009 by Jim LaPierre. It is a for-profit agency but does a lot of pro-bono work.
- They accept all types of insurance, as well as a sliding scale fees.
- Services include mental health counseling, substance use counseling, adult case management, group therapy, dual diagnosis treatment, mental health assessments, after care trauma care recovery, anger management, and more.
- Abbie is a dual diagnosis counseling and case manager and works directly with those experiencing homelessness.
- Provide section 17 services in particular hard to access service as its for people with persistent mental health issues and/or those with specific diagnosis. Must be at risk under certain criteria.
 Folks that meet this are face a lot of barriers. This is funded through Maine Care and is a requirement to access service. Eligible for two hours a week of services.
- With behavioral health home option case managers are limited in how many hours they can spend with a client and it is not enough to help folks get off the street.
- Works with PATH team and City Outreach worker and they have more flexibility. Depending on funding source, restrictions are common and vary by source and agency.
- Biggest challenge is helping folks access insurance, services they need, and the barriers.
- Case managers commonly have 30-35 clients each. Tracking folks down is difficult. Dangers that
 case managers face was explained. Folks can be experiencing severe mental health diagnosis
 and also be addicted to drugs but unable to access healthcare. Case managers trying to find
 clients, such as waking someone up in woods can be scary and often results in just helping them
 meet their immediate needs.
- Pandemic, along with being understaffed, did open up services online but also created additional problems for providers.
- Largest barrier is getting folks housed and keeping it. They often lack skills to help with basic needs to be able to maintain housing. Noncompliance is also an issue because if your friend is still on street and you've been housed, they will often invite to help others but its against the rules of their voucher or apartment. Its hard for folks to understand. But also getting out-of-state landlords to accept vouchers or take a risk is a challenge.
- Funding dictates rules. Section 92 is broader but not many offer necessary case managers.
