

Request for Proposals Aircraft Deicing & Anti-Icing Fluid Proposal No. P24-55 Purchasing Department 262 Harlow Street Bangor, ME 04401 207-992-4282

I. Introduction

The City of Bangor (City) is requesting proposals from qualified Proposers to furnish and deliver aircraft deicing and anti-icing fluid, FOB Destination to the Bangor International Airport, 287 Godfrey Boulevard, Bangor, Maine, for a period of three (3) years. Three (3) additional one (1)-year period renewal options are contemplated, contingent upon the mutual agreement of the parties. The products and their delivery shall comply with the specifications contained in this request. The City reserves the right to issue the award to two (2) Proposers. The City will not consider proposals that include the use of recycled or reclaimed fluids.

II. General Information

By submitting a response to this solicitation, the Proposer accepts the responsibility for downloading, reading, and bidding by the terms and conditions set forth in the City's "General Information for Vendors".

In your proposal, please specify whether you currently have or are in the process of developing a domestic violence policy. If you do not have such a policy, let us know if you would like to receive a copy of the City of Bangor's policy as a reference.

III. Submission

For consideration, submit the proposal Bid Form, pages six (6) and seven (7), as well as the materials requested in Section XI. *Bid Requirements* in an envelope marked "Proposal No. P24-55: Aircraft Deicing & Anti-Icing Fluid" by 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 24, 2024.

All submissions should reference "Proposal No. P24-55: Aircraft Deicing & Antilcing Fluid". Proposals will be publicly opened at the time stated above in the temporary Council Chambers, 262 Harlow Street, Bangor, Maine (see Appendix A -Meeting Location Map).

A tabulation of all received proposals will be posted on the City's website by 4:30 P.M. on the opening date. Visit www.bangormaine.gov/bidtabs for results.

IV. Questions

Any questions must be directed in writing to bids@bangormaine.gov no later than 4:30 P.M., **Friday**, **July 5, 2024**.

The City will provide a response by 4:30 P.M. on **Friday**, **July 12**, **2024**. This response will be in the form of an addendum, accessible on the City's website. Notifications will be sent to the Registered Vendor List when new addenda are released. To receive these updates, the City strongly encourages all potential bidders to register as vendors at www.bangormaine.gov/vendorregistration.

V. Late Proposals

It is the responsibility of the Proposer(s) to see that their proposals have sufficient time to be received by the Purchasing Department before the submittal deadline. Any proposal, portion of a proposal, or requested proposal revision received at the City Purchasing Department after the time and date specified, will be returned to the Proposer unopened.

VI. Withdrawal of Proposals

No Proposer may withdraw their proposal for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening. All proposals shall be subject to acceptance by the City during this period.

To withdraw a proposal prior to the opening, the Proposer shall request the withdrawal in writing. All costs associated with the withdrawal (i.e. mailing fees) will be borne by the Proposer.

VII. Rejection

The City reserves the right to reject any proposals, waive any informalities or defects in proposals, or accept a higher cost proposal if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City. The City also reserves the right to request clarification, of any details, from the successful Proposer.

VIII. Information for Proposers

- A. All Federal and State taxes must be excluded from the proposal price. Upon request, a tax exemption certificate for the City of Bangor shall be furnished to the successful Proposer.
- B. The Bid Form, included with this request, must be completed and returned for a proposal to be considered.

IX. Estimated Annual Requirements

This solicitation covers estimated annual requirements only and is not a commitment to purchase. Delivery shall be made only as specifically authorized by the City of Bangor. If City requirements do not result in orders for the quantities noted, such events shall not constitute the basis for a price adjustment.

X. Term of Agreement

The contract shall be effective August 31, 2024, and continue through June 30, 2027. The option to renew for three (3) additional one (1)-year periods is contemplated, contingent upon the mutual agreement of both parties.

XI. Bid Requirements

The following information must be provided with all proposals:

- A. Transition instructions from the current type of fluids the City uses to the proposed fluid.
- B. Documentation stating the product has been certified in the United States.
- C. Material Data Sheets (MSDS).

XII. Delivery Terms

- A. Delivery of all fluids must be made within 24 hours of an order being placed.
- B. Delivery requirements for Type I and Type IV minimum delivery of approximately five thousand 5,000 gallons shall be delivered to a 5,000-gallon tank. Full or partial deliveries may be requested.

XIII. Specifications


